Icebreaker

Describe (or show) the worst picture ever taken of you.

Read John 4

What stood out to you from Clayton's message/our passage?

What are some unhelpful pictures of Jesus that you have been taught in your life?

Jesus was intentional to go through Samaria in order to have a conversation with the Samaritan woman. Jesus pursues this woman, and continues to pursue us now. **How does this change our view of Jesus?**

How does Jesus go about sharing the Gospel with this woman?

Jesus claims that He is the living water. He asked the woman if she wanted the living water and she said yes. But Jesus doesn't allow her to just say yes, he mentions her past 5 husbands and calls her out of sin. Instead of a simple yes to living water he presses in. We do the same thing. Why does Jesus call her sin out? How does Jesus go about calling out her sin? How does Jesus continue to do this with us?

Clayton mentioned on Sunday that "we don't share our faith with others because we don't believe Jesus has the power to heal us". Where do you see this playing out in your life?

Jesus affirms that the woman's worship was in the wrong place, she changes the point of the question to where she should worship not who she should worship.

The woman shares with others what Jesus has done for her. Evangelism is a natural overflow of our faith in Jesus.
