

## **CHRISTIANITY AND SEXUAL ETHICS (ACTS 17:16-34)**

**CONNECT**—Think of a fun-icebreaker question to ask. For example, what is your single most embarrassing haircut or style decision from your childhood?

### **DISCUSS**

What most stood out to you from Justin’s sermon this past week? What was one of your big takeaways?

If you had to list pros and cons of the sexual revolution, what would be some of the things that you would list? In your opinion, has the sexual revolution had a positive or negative effect on our culture?

### **Read Genesis 1:26-28, 31; 2:18-25**

How is the picture of sexuality in these verses different than what you have heard from most Christians? Why is this picture of sexuality good news?

How could seeing these truths about sex free someone from sexual sin?

“Christianity has a problem with the way that our culture approaches sex not because we have a low view of sex. No. No. No. Christianity has an infinitely higher view of the goodness and significance of sex and our problem is that our culture is trivializing and physicalizing it. Sex is very good.” Do you agree or disagree? Why is this important to know?

### **Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11**

What stands out to you in these verses?

What are some of the right ways to approach and engage with the LGBTQ community? What are, in your opinion, some of the wrong ways?

**RELATE**—Consider splitting into guys and girls for this section.

### **Read John 8:1-11**

In all honesty, where do you feel most like the woman caught in adultery? How have you experienced Jesus’ grace in that area?

What has been your biggest spiritual highlight this week? What has been your biggest spiritual struggle this week? What is one action step that you are going to take this week in light of this discussion?

**IMPACT** (Invite, Engage, Share)

Who is one person that you can invite to church this week.
