## Agreement with the Worship Director

- I agree to learn my parts and I will ask the Worship Director or leader for help if needed.
- I agree to bring issues I am having with the worship ministry to the Worship Director.
- I agree to let the Worship Director know ASAP if I can't attend rehearsal.
- I agree to treat all equipment with respect
