### **Galatians 1:6-10**

On Sunday we saw the true gospel compared side-by-side with a different gospel that is no gospel at all.

God moves, we respond	We move, God responds
We don't deserve it	We do deserve it
Based on Christ's efforts	Based on our efforts
Good news	Not good news

What stands out to you most in the contrast between these two "gospels"? What are some ways that you have, "gotten the gospel wrong"?

The true Gospel is a calling IN grace FROM Christ. What would you say the source of salvation is in our culture?

What is so radical about what Paul's portrayal of the Gospel in these verses?

Justin drew our attention to this idea of a "Christianized" version of the gospel that is no gospel at all. What are some ways that you see a Christianized version of the different gospel that is no gospel at all in our country or our area?

When we think that we must deserve God's favor to receive God's favor, we will swing between pride and condemnation. How have you seen this in your life?

What is so enticing to so many people about this different gospel that is no Gospel at all?

What does it practically look like to rest in the goodness of the Good News of the Gospel?
